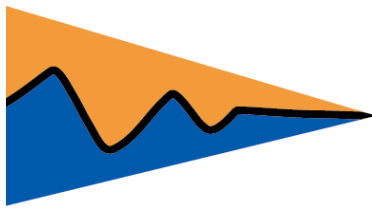


2009 Canadian Laser Masters Championships

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The 2009 Canadian Laser Masters Championships Regatta will be raced in the Laser dinghy. The competitor must be 35 or older on June 19th, 2009. Eligible competitors may enter by completing the online registration on the Wabamun Sailing Club web site and by bringing the signed registration form to the onsite registration office.

Competitors who register and pay by June 10th, 2009 will receive a \$20 discount. To receive this discount, the registration form and payment must be postmarked no later than June 10th, 2009 or the online registration process and payment must be completed by June 10th, 2009.

The Wabamun Sailing Club is located 60 km west of Edmonton on Lake Wabamun.

The last race on June 21st, 2009 will not start later than 15:00 hours.

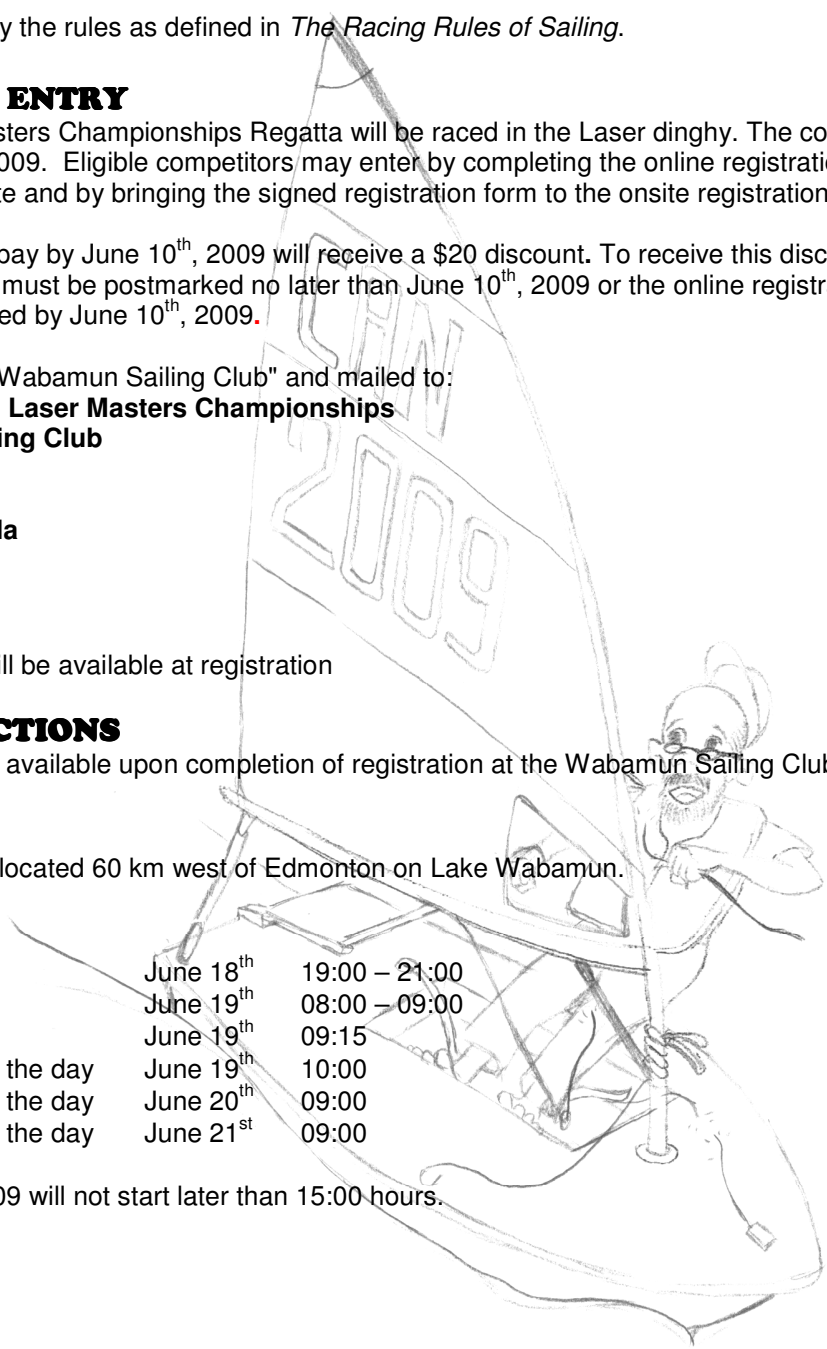
7. PENALTIES

9. SCORING

Eleven races are scheduled of which one race must be completed to constitute a series.

- (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When from 5 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- b) When from 8 to 11 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst two scores.

The North American Laser Masters' age adjusted scoring system will be used to determine the 2009 Canadian Laser Masters Championships.

10. COURSES

The diagrams in diagram 1 show the courses, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13. PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded based on the following numbers of boats per Laser Masters age division:

- 2-5 boats 1st place
- 6-9 boats 1st & 2nd places
- 10 or more boats 1st, 2nd & 3rd places

There will be an overall female award if 3 female master sailors are registered by June 10th.

14. INSURANCE

Each participant is responsible to ensure that he/she is covered by valid liability insurance.

15. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In participating in the event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organizing authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the said event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said event without compensation.

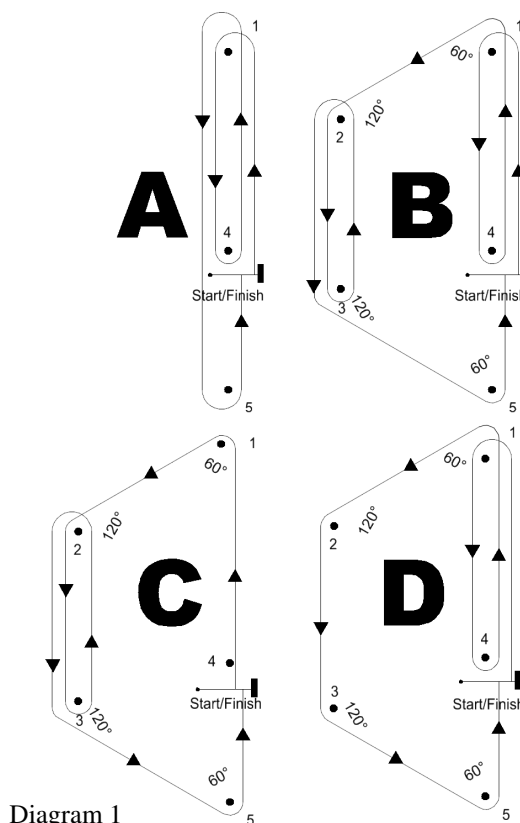

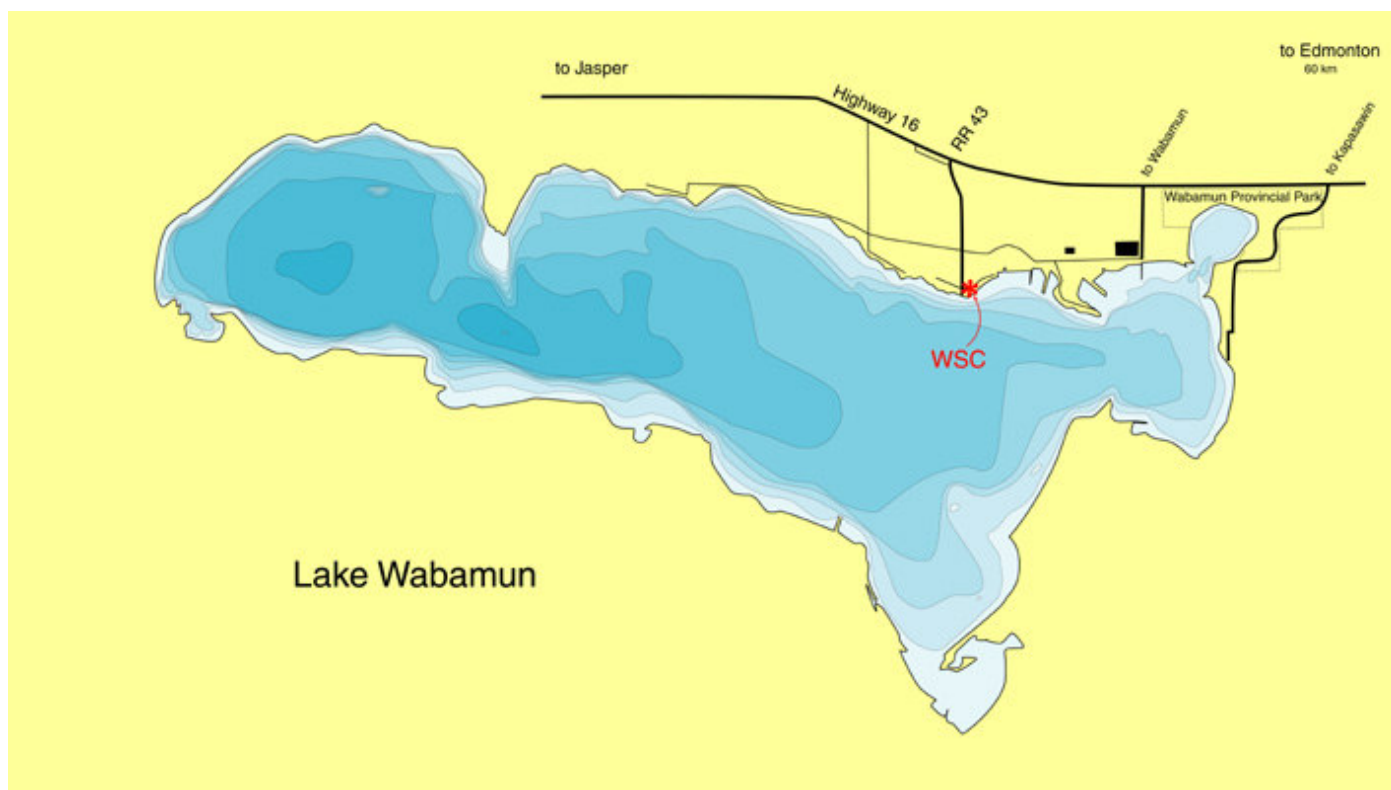

Directions to the Wabamun Sailing Club:
